

Brisbane State High School (BSHS) has a strong tradition of excellence in the Performing Arts, in particular Instrumental Music. Students who join the Instrumental Music Program must play a concert band or orchestral instrument and are offered the opportunity to experience a variety of musical styles across a range of performance events.

The Enrolment Management Plan (EMP) for BSHS allows for selective entry in a number of categories. Specific details about the categories, selection processes and timelines for applications can be found on the school website <u>www.statehigh.com.au</u>.

Students who enrol under the Cultural (Instrumental Music) Selective Entry Category are required to join the instrumental classes. This includes group lessons which are held in school time (Brass, Woodwind, Strings, Percussion) from Year 7 through to Year 10 and in ensembles through to Year 12.

Please note, Instrumental Music does not include piano or guitar.

From year to year the need for specific instruments for inclusion in the school program may vary, depending on existing music enrolments and the balance of instruments within ensembles. The school, therefore, has absolute discretionary power to determine in which musical activities, and to which students in a particular activity, it has the capacity to offer assistance and support.

Students applying for entry into Year 7 2024 must have achieved a minimum standard equivalent to:

- AMEB Grade 6 for violin
- AMEB Grade 5 for flute
- AMEB Grade 4 for most other instruments.
- Percussion applications are for orchestral percussion. Applications on Drum Kit alone will not be considered.
- Horn, Tuba, Double Bass **may be** considered at a lower level.

In cases where a student has not completed AMEB examinations, the student may submit a reference from a registered and practicing Education Queensland instrumental music teacher and/or registered and practicing private tutor, stipulating that the student is playing at the specified AMEB level.

Application Dates

All applications are required to be completed online via the <u>Selective Entry Online Application Form</u>. The **closing date** for Instrumental Music applications is **Monday 17 June 2024**. Applications received after this date will not be considered.

Audition Dates

Auditions for students will be conducted on **Thursday 25 July 2024 and Friday 26 July 2024** in the BSHS Performing Arts Centre (PAC). Parents will be advised by email of the specific time of their child's audition once all registrations have been received.

Audition Requirements

Students are required to prepare two contrasting works in full. These works should be selected to demonstrate the applicant's technical and musical proficiency. The pieces selected should be at a level at least equivalent to the minimum standards outlined above. Musicians should also be prepared to demonstrate technical work (Scales, arpeggios etc. appropriate to the minimum standards outlined above). Sight reading will also be included in the audition process. Percussion applicants should be prepared to play on Mallet Percussion, Untuned percussion and Timpani. Percussion instruments will be provided for prospective applicants. All other musicians are required to provide their own instrument for audition.

Post Audition

Parents/guardians will be notified in writing via email of the outcome of their child's application. Students **must have** demonstrated ability in instrumental music at the required minimum standards, school reports that reflect an ability to cope with the academic demands of the BSHS curriculum and above average behaviour reports.

Note

Brisbane State High School does not offer music scholarships. All students who are enrolled into the school under Cultural Selective Entry – Instrumental Music are required to pay all normal school fees and other charges associated with participation in extracurricular activities.
