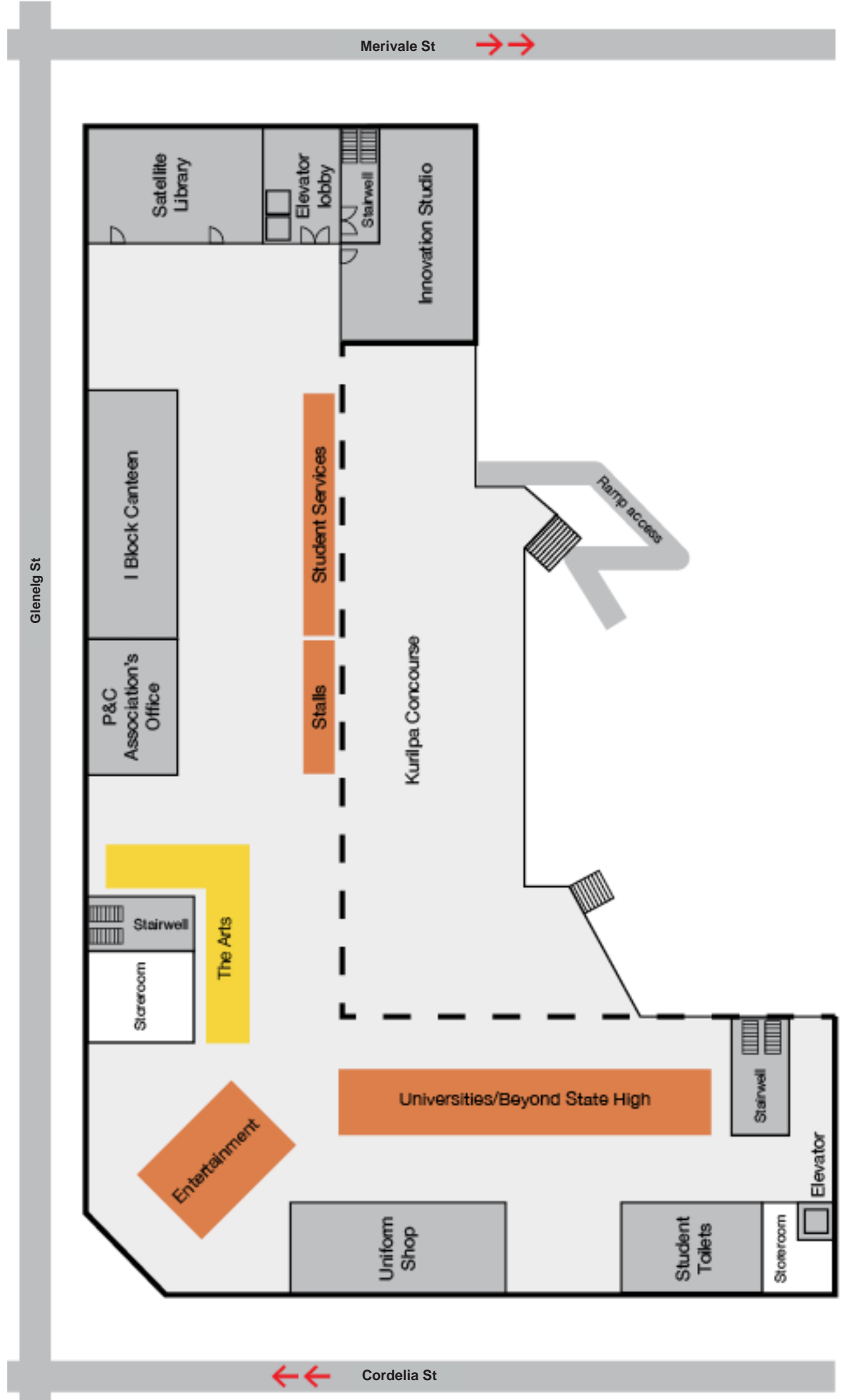

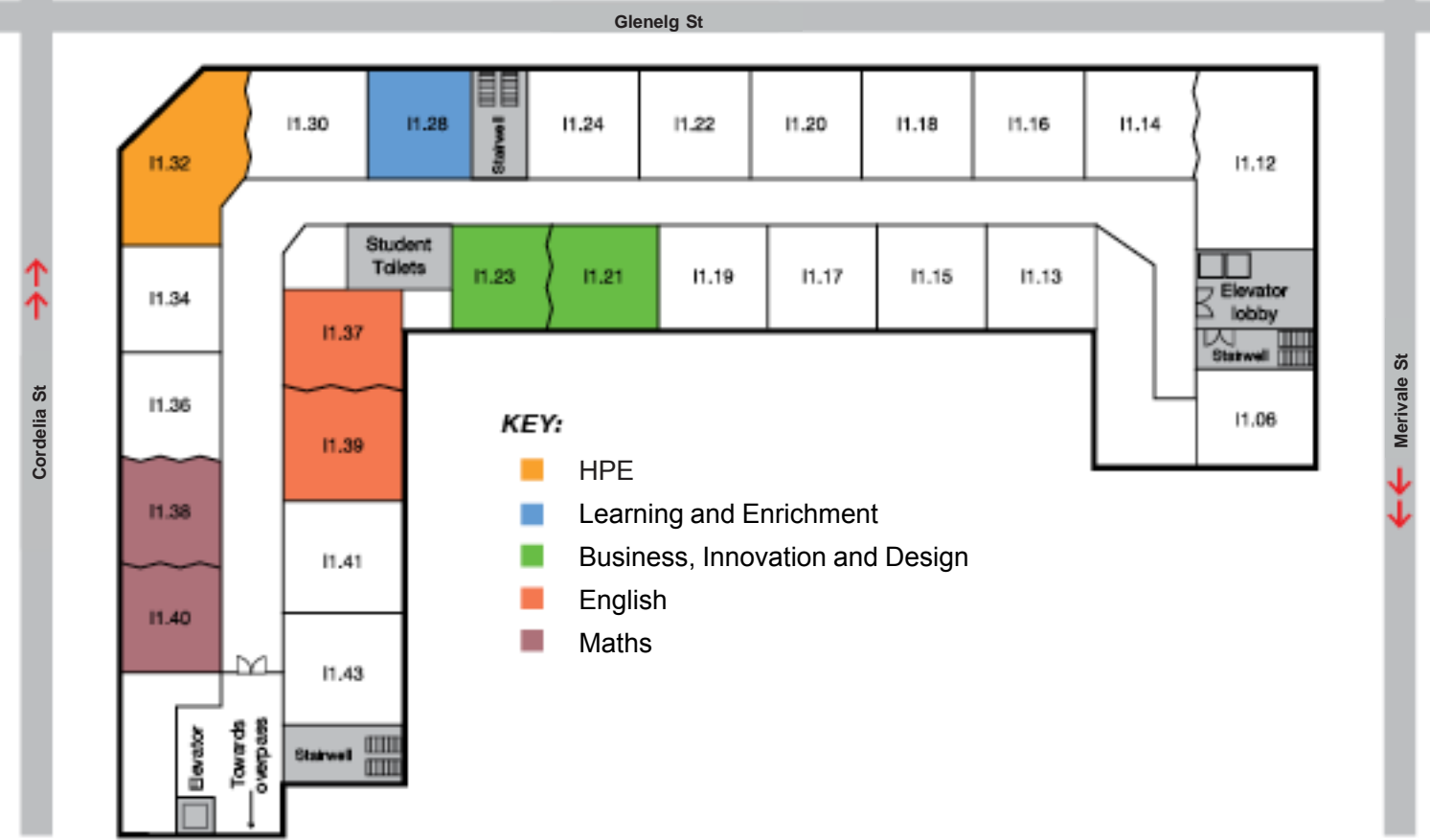


I Block Map | Level 1
