

BRISBANE STATE HIGH SCHOOL

As a member of the QGSSSA (Queensland Girls Secondary Schools Sports Association), Brisbane State High School is involved in the wide range of sporting activities coordinated by this organisation.

The school's Enrolment Management Plan (<u>EMP</u>) allows for selective entry in a number of categories. Specific details about the categories, selection processes and timelines for applications can be found on the school website – <u>www.statehigh.com.au</u>. All persons interested in enrolment should read the relevant information.

To identify potential applicants for Sporting Selective Entry – Cricket for Year 7, 2025, a cricket trial will be conducted.

Procedures for players wishing to trial are as follows:

- 1. Complete the <u>Selective Entry Online Application form</u> from Friday 22 March 2024.
- Submit the online application and the required supporting documents by Tuesday 30 April 2024, along with:
 Birth Certificate (copy)
 - Year 5 (2023) Semester 1 and Semester 2 school reports
 - Year 6 (2024) Semester 1 school report (when available)
 - Most current NAPLAN Report
 - Trial registration form (see page 2)
 - Sporting Selective Entry Application Checklist and Student Summary form (see pages 3 5)
 - Evidence of Application to Trial fee payment (i.e. \$100) to be paid via the Qkr! App.
 - Please note: A non-refundable, non-transferrable Application to Trial processing fee of \$100 applies for all applications to trial. For applicants offered enrolment, this processing fee will be deducted from the \$420 fee applicable for Selective Entry Enrolment applications*.
 *Please note, if you have already paid the \$420 Selective Entry fee in 2024, the trial fee is not applicable.

Note: All Selective Entry Applications are required to be completed online via the Selective Entry Online Application form. Students <u>must have</u> demonstrated ability in cricket (e.g. selection in representative teams/squads), school reports that reflect an ability to cope with the academic demands of the BSHS curriculum and above average behaviour reports.

Trial Information

The trial will be held on **Sunday, 26 May 2024** at the Brisbane State High School oval. Players invited to attend the trial will receive a written invitation during the week commencing 20 May 2024. Specific details of what students need to bring to the trial will be included with the invitation.

Post-Trial

Students who are shortlisted and whose school academic and behaviour reports are deemed to be of a suitably high standard will proceed to the final stage of the enrolment process. At this time, payment of \$320 for the balance of the non-refundable processing fee required for a Selective Entry application (\$420) will be required to be paid via the Qkr! App.

Note

Brisbane State High School does not offer sporting scholarships. All students who are enrolled into the school under Sporting Selective Entry – Cricket are required to pay all normal school fees and other charges associated with participation in extra-curricular activities.
