Guest Speakers: Genevieve Nissen – House Leader, Year 12, and Francis Lau and Samuel Zhu – Student Members

Francis Lau explained the function of the Junior School Leadership Group which provides an opportunity for Year 9 students.

Guest presenter Genevieve Nissen (House Captain, Year 12) spoke about the House and Spirit leadership groups. Their main goal for this year has been to build connections and spirit and promote a community feeling within the Houses.

Samuel Zhu explained the role of Prefects, the Student Representative Council (SRC) and Peers for Academic Success (PAS).

We have 31 Prefects who work on activities aimed to increase culture and engagement of students.



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The SRC is one of the biggest groups in the school with over 200 students involved. There are five to six leaders who manage these students. The SRC has the opportunity to be involved in voluntary activities and to hold fundraisers for charities.

Peers for Academic Success (PAS) is a mentorship program.

These student groups attend a Student Leadership Forum each term where they hear from guest speakers, discuss different initiatives and learn what the other groups are involved in.

Guest Speaker: Melissa Buirchell – President, P&C Association

Melissa Buirchell discussed the P&C Strategic Plan and the purpose of the P&C. The P&C works in productive partnership with the school and the community to enhance the outcomes of students. Any profits made from P&C activities, along with fundraising efforts, support and enhance programs and projects within the school.
