2. Topics for decision

2.1 AIP (Wade Haynes)

The Annual Improvement Plan was tabled and discussed.

2.2 Draft Budget (Amanda Chamberlain)

The draft budget was tabled and discussed, noting that revenue has not changed significantly from 2022, the inclusion of \$3.1M to develop the courts at our Fursden Road Playing Fields, and that faculty budgets remain very similar to 2022.

Motion: That the 2023 Budget be endorsed.

3. Topics for discussion

3.1 Strategic Development 2023 (Wade Haynes)

It was noted that the Assistant Executive Principals' portfolios align with strategic development (Emily Simons) and strategic alignment (Bindi Lodge).

The School Philosophy is undergoing a refresh with input being sought from a working party consisting of staff, parents and students.

A number of new strategy plans are being developed over 2023, with targeted consultation.

3.2 Alumni Engagement (Wade Haynes)

The Council considered the engagement and benefits of alumni with a robust conversation being ensued.

3.3 Enrolment Strategy (Nancy Cole)

Nancy Cole presented 'Strengthening our school identity' and a discussion followed.

Families are known to move out of the catchment once they have secured their child's place at State High. Attempts to change the legislation have failed.

The Council was asked to consider the ratio of selective entry to local catchment enrolments for discussion at a future meeting.
