1. Masterclass Considerations:

- Check the year level suitability for each masterclass. Some are for junior students and some for senior students.
- Some face-to-face masterclasses reach capacity quickly. Placements will be given on a 'first in' basis in order of registration.
- Certain programs depend on minimum numbers for viability.
- Some masterclasses include a fee.
