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Students **must have** demonstrated ability in cricket (e.g. selection in representative teams/squads); school reports that reflect an ability to cope with the academic demands of the BSHS curriculum and above average behaviour reports.

This is a closed cricket trial. Players selected to attend the trial will receive a written invitation by Monday 25 February 2019. Specific details of what students need to bring to the trial at 9:00am–12:00pm on **Sunday 3 March 2019** at the BSHS Oval will be included with the invitation.

Note: Brisbane State High School does not offer sporting scholarships.

All students who are enrolled into the school under sporting merit are required to pay all normal school fees and other charges associated with participation in co-curricular activities.
