

## APPLICATION FORM – YEAR 7, 2020

At Brisbane State High School, we offer a two year selective entry Enrichment Program called 'Aspire'. The Aspire Program comprises of two strands of study for Year 7 and 8:

1. Maths/Science; and
2. English/Humanities.

The courses offered explore topics in greater breadth and depth than normally required and thus enable learners to develop an appreciation of the wider context of the subject area. All students, regardless of enrolment category (Local Catchment, Academic Selective Entry, Sporting Selective Entry or Cultural Selective Entry – Art or Music), must apply to be considered for this program.

### Application Guidelines

- Students are able to apply for one or two strands of study.
- Students are required to complete the application indicating for which chosen strand/s of study they are applying and provide photocopies of relevant documents. (Even if previously supplied to the school, copies will need to be provided with this application.)
- If applying for more than one strand of study, students are not required to submit more than one written response.
- There are limited spaces available; places will be made on the selection criteria:
  - Semester 1 Report Card (achievement, effort and behaviour)
  - NAPLAN Year 5 Report
  - Diagnostic testing results undertaken in 2019, e.g. ICAS, REACH, PAT Tests, MYAT
  - Handwritten response to question (on page 3)
- Late or incomplete applications will not be processed or considered.
- Should your application for Aspire courses be unsuccessful, you will be automatically placed in a non-Aspire class.
- Ongoing enrolment in this two year program will rely on the student's performance and efforts; this will be reviewed at specific junctures. Students will be required to:
  - Meet a minimum 'B' level of achievement in Aspire subjects studied;
  - Adhere to high level of expectations through achievement, effort, behaviour and homework.

**In all cases, the Executive Principal's decision will be final.**
