## RUGBY REUNION IN 2016

In the 2016 GPS rugby season there will be a reunion to celebrate **State High's** four consecutive 1<sup>st</sup> XV premierships in 1973, 1974, 1975 and 1976. Planning is underway and information will be published in *AMICUS* and posted on the school website. Watch this space for details!!!!

In 1973, **State High** won the 1<sup>st</sup> XV GPS premiership in conjunction with BGS, whose captain was **Graham Noon**. Graham was selected as the captain of the Australian Schoolboys' team to tour the UK which included **State High's Tom Barker, Peter Garbe, Mark Porter, Don Regeling** and **Tim Trehearn**. Graham is a long term teacher and the GPS Director of Sport and Activities at **State High**.

In 1974, **State High** won the 1<sup>st</sup> XV GPS premiership undefeated in conjunction with Churchie. **Tom Barker, Mark Porter** and **Tim Trehearn** were selected in the Australian Schoolboys' team that played England.

In 1975, **State High** won the 1<sup>st</sup> XV GPS premiership undefeated. **Ron Jamieson** and **Col Milligan** were selected in the Australian Schoolboys' team to tour New Zealand. **Chris Roche** was also selected in the Australian team from Downlands College and future Australian rugby league captain and **State High** legend **Wally Lewis** was in the **State High** 1<sup>st</sup> XV.

In 1976, **State High** won the 1<sup>st</sup> XV GPS premiership in conjunction with BGS, becoming the first school to win four rugby premierships in a row. **Nick Barker, Wally Lewis, Chris Roche** and **Paul Scholes** were selected in the Australian Schoolboys' team. A most satisfying statistic from the 1976 season was that the 1<sup>st</sup> XV did not have their line crossed and conceded only a total of 24 points via eight penalties in the eight premiership games.

The 1970's were the domain of **Jim Lucey (BSHS Staff 1964-1979)**. Jim was instrumental to the success of **State High** rugby in that era and remains a most respected figure in rugby circles. Jim coached all 1<sup>st</sup> XV teams from 1968 to 1979, which included five premierships.

These statistics and the 25 premierships won in the other open and underage divisions from 1973 to 1976 should provide an inspiration to **State High** rugby teams in the 2016 GPS season.

## SHAKESPEARE RETOLD

Australian Children's Laureate, 2015 Senior Australian of the Year and author **Jackie French's**, Class of 1970, latest publication is a retelling of Shakespeare's play *Hamlet* through the eyes of the heroine, Ophelia. *Ophelia – Queen of Denmark* is the second of a series of works based on Shakespeare's plays and follows on from her previous publication *I am Juliet*.

## THE MONEY MEN

The **Hon William G Hayden AC**, Class of 1949 and **State High** Legend, is included in a recent publication *The Money Men: Australia's Most Notable Treasurers*. **Hayden** was the **21st Governor-General of Australia** from 1989 to 1996. He was previously the **Leader of the Labor Party** and **Leader of the Opposition** from 1977 to 1983, and served as **Minister for Foreign Affairs and Trade** under **Prime Minister Bob Hawke** from 1983 to 1988. Earlier in his career he had been the **Treasurer of Australia** under **Gough Whitlam** in 1975. This appointment resulted in his inclusion in the current publication in which he receives a glowing endorsement.

## MUSEUM DONATIONS

Past students continue to donate their treasured memorabilia from their school days at **State High** to the school museum. **Chris Robson**, School Captain 1979, donated his school magazines from 1975-1979, which included the much sought after 1977 magazine.

**Mike McMullen**, Athletics captain 1982, who now works and resides in the USA, parted with valuable athletic memorabilia. During the 1982 Athletic Season the Athletics Team weekly newsletter, "Athlete's Foot", carried the words, "Honour the Past – Challenge the Future". For the 1982 **BSHS** Athletics Team, the past was honoured by the challenging and securing of eight GPS Athletic Premierships in succession. **State High** went on to win its ninth GPS Athletics Premiership in a row in 1983. Many thanks to Chris and Mike and the many other past students who parted with their treasured memorabilia which will be preserved in the museum for the benefit of future generations.

## delicious MAGAZINE

NewsLifeMedia has announced that **Kerrie McCallum (Alcorn)**, Class of 1991, will step into the role of editor-in-chief of ABC *delicious* magazine. Kerrie, who is the editor-in-chief of Australia's premier weekly glossy insert *Sunday Style*, will oversee both titles. *delicious* magazine celebrates food and the people who produce it, from emerging and established chefs, to passionate 'foodies' from around Australia and the rest of the world.



### UNSW Solar Cell Technology

Solar cell technology developed by Australia’s world leading University of NSW solar research team is likely to become the standard for global manufacturers within 5 years, ushering in new dramatic falls in the cost of solar technology.

**Professor Martin Green**, Dux and Class of 1965, the head of the UNSW solar research team, says the PERC technology developed by UNSW was likely to become standard in more than half of all solar cell production across the globe by 2020. PERC stands for Passivated Emitter and Rear Cell. Essentially, it is a technique that ensures that solar rays, which were once absorbed into the module, are instead reflected back to the rear of the solar cell, so ensuring that its efficiency is increased. This will help accelerate the push to greater efficiency (as the standard moves from near 20 per cent to beyond 25 per cent) and, in turn, help to continue the remarkably rapid fall in solar costs over the last 5 years. Researchers have been working on this for several decades, but the technique developed by UNSW is easily applicable to global manufacturing operations. Already, PERC is used in 10 per cent of global capacity. By 2020, Professor Green, who was inducted as a Legend of **State High** in 2014, says that it will be used in more than half of all solar cell production.

The painting references Hans Holbein’s 16<sup>th</sup> century masterpiece “The Ambassadors”, which is an almost life size allegorical portrait of two men from Henry VIII’s Tudor court.

### Graduates of 1950 gathered to remember

Reading the proposed reunions listed in VOL 42 No 1 of *AMICUS* made me realise that it was 65 years since I had graduated from my ALMA MATER. Hence the germ of a seed was firmly planted. Approx 101 students graduated from BSBS in 1950, which meant that those remaining would be in their early eighties. I booked a Banquet Lunch at the Greek Club in Edmondstone Street requesting space to house the walkers, walking frames, wheel chairs or whatever else attendees needed for their mobility. Mailed 70 invites back in March 2015 [giving people time to organise themselves, travel, accommodation, doctor’s appointments etc.] prior to the scheduled Reunion Party Lunch on Saturday October 3rd. In response I discovered that at least 24 of our 101 were deceased, several had health issues and distance prevented some from attending and others said “God willing I’ll be there!!!!”. Panic set in. “Shall I cancel, will I still go ahead, what shall I do?”

Fourteen of the 1950 graduates did gather at the Greek Club to celebrate. Also in attendance were a past student son, several supportive spouses and **Barry Irwin**, Registrar of the **BSBS PSA** & Editor of *AMICUS*. Informality throughout proceedings resulted in lots of chatter, shared memories, laughter and enjoyment. We appreciated hearing Barry bring us up to date in regard to **BSBS’s** role in today’s society. He then invited those who wished, to visit the **BSBS** Museum where we would be able to revisit records related to the history of our Alma Mater. On completion of this reunion, the organiser breathed a sigh of relief in the knowledge that all the attendees had departed with newly created memories to add to those of the past treasured 65 years.
