

Year 12 Results 2018



Our students have, again, worked hard to achieve outstanding results in their 2018 studies. The 2018 group have achieved best-ever results in a number of areas, best for State High and, in some cases, the best in Queensland's history.

A total of 67 students or 15%, achieved an OP1. This is the highest number of OP1 ever, in Queensland. One hundred and thirty students achieved an OP1 or 2, which is 29%. When bonus ranks are considered these numbers swell to 120 students (22.4%) with results equivalent to an OP1.

The number of very high achieving students is impressive. These are all extraordinarily high percentages of students as well. The median score for the group was 5. 29% of the OP eligible students were enrolled on academic merit, 48% on local entry and 22% on sport or cultural entry.

Over the last 6 years, OP results have been strong. The number of OP1s was 67, 59, 51, 46, 35 and 41, an average of 50 per year.

535 (100%) students achieved a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) or Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement (QCIA). 85% of students were OP eligible.

The Queensland Core Skills (QCS) Test Results were also strong:

Our students also achieved a record number of Vocational Qualifications. 506 students achieved a full Certificate or Diploma, with a total of 644 qualifications achieved. We had 48 students achieve a Diploma. 16 students achieved a Certificate IV, 84 a Certificate III and 473 a Certificate II.

46 students completed a University Semester whilst at school.

Of course, these results are one indication of the high quality of learning in classrooms over the last few years. Our students have learned skills, knowledge and values that will stand them in good stead as they continue to learn, work and contribute to society. These results are also the means to gain entry to University and other courses, here and around the world. Early information is that over 453 students have been offered placements in a Queensland University.
