

Year 12 Results 2016



Our students have, again, worked hard to achieve outstanding results in their 2016 studies.

A total of 51 students, a little over 11%, achieved an OP1. Exactly 100 students achieved an OP1 or 2. When bonus ranks are considered, these numbers swell to 98 students (22%) with results equivalent to an OP1 and 131 (29.4%) with OP1 or 2.

The theme of half centuries and centuries continued with the OP1-5, OP1-10 and OP1-15 results, with over 200, 300 and 400 students respectively. These are all extraordinarily high numbers of students. The median score for the group was 6.

Over the last five years, OP results have been strong. The average number of OP1s is 42 and 11%.

513 (99.4%) students achieved a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) or Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement (QCIA) at this point in time.

The Queensland Core Skills (QCS) Test results were also strong:

Our students also achieved a record number of Vocational qualifications. We had 379 students achieve a Certificate or Diploma. In our first year with graduates in Diploma courses, we had 23 students make this achievement. Eighteen students achieved a Certificate IV, 81 a Certificate III and 325 a Certificate II.

Of course, these results are one indication of the high quality of learning in classrooms over the last few years. Our students have learned skills, knowledge and values that will stand them in good stead as they continue to learn, work and contribute to society. These results are also the means to gain entry to University and other courses, here and around the world. Early information is that over 430 students have secured placements in Queensland Universities.
