

Year 12 Results 2017



Our students have, again, worked hard to achieve outstanding results in their 2017 studies. The 2017 group have achieved best-ever results in a number of areas, best for State High and, in some cases, the best in Queensland's history.

A total of 59 students, a little under 14%, achieved an OP1. This is the highest number of OP1 ever, in Queensland. One hundred and twenty-five students achieved an OP1 or 2, which is 29%.

When bonus ranks are considered these numbers swell to 116 students (27%) with results equivalent to an OP1 and 164 (48%) with OP1 or 2.

The theme of half centuries and centuries continued with the OP1-5, OP1-10 and OP1-15 results, with over 200, 300 and 400 students respectively. These are all extraordinarily high numbers of students. The median score for the group was 5, and very close to being a 4.

Over the last 5 years, OP results have been strong. The number of OP1s was 59, 51, 46, 35 and 41, an average of 44.4.

528 (100%) students achieved a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE).

The Queensland Core Skills (QCS) Test Results were also strong:

Our students also achieved a record number of Vocational Qualifications. 480 students achieved a full Certificate or Diploma, with a total of 598 qualifications achieved. We had 46 students achieve a Diploma. 16 students achieved a Certificate IV, 92 a Certificate III and 444 a Certificate II.

Of course, these results are one indication of the high quality of learning in classrooms over the last few years. Our students have learned skills, knowledge and values that will stand them in good stead as they continue to learn, work and contribute to society. These results are also the means to gain entry to University and other courses, here and around the world. Early information is that over 448 students have been offered placements in a Queensland University.
