

Brisbane State High School (BSHS) has a strong tradition of excellence in The Arts.

The school's Enrolment Management Plan (<u>EMP</u>) allows for selective entry in a number of categories. Specific details about the categories, selection processes and timelines for applications can be found on the school website <u>www.statehigh.com.au</u>.

As a part of the application for Cultural (Visual Art) Selective Entry, students must submit a folio of 10 original works that best demonstrate their artistic ability. The works should be no larger than A3 in size. Photographs of larger works, 3D and sculptural work and USBs of time-based/digital media work may be included in the folio. Please note, a physical copy of the folio is required to be submitted.

Folios will be assessed on a student's:

- analytical and interpretative drawing skills (ability to draw from life and to express and interpret through the drawing medium)
- experimentation with concepts, subject matter or materials (willingness to go beyond the standard convention of the medium and strive for innovation and originality)
- ability to interpret, express and communicate ideas (clarity and intent of ideas and aesthetic achievement).

Students in Year 6 applying for Cultural (Visual Art) Selective Entry into Year 7 may also be invited to attend a workshop to demonstrate their skills.

Application Dates

All applications are required to be completed online via the <u>Selective Entry Online Application Form</u>. Applications open on **Friday 2 May 2025**. The **closing date** for Visual Art applications is **Monday 16 June 2025**. The student's art folio must also be received by **4.00pm on Monday**, **16 June**. Folios are to be submitted to the H Block Reception Office. Applications received after this date will not be considered.

Workshop

Students may be invited to attend a Visual Art Workshop Assessment at BSHS on **Saturday**, **19 July 2025**. Parents will be notified in writing by email if their child is invited to attend the workshop assessment.

Post Workshop

Families will be notified in writing via email with regards to the outcome of their application.

Student art folios will be available for collection from the H Block Reception Office following completion of the selection process.

Note

Brisbane State High School does not offer scholarships. All students who are enrolled into the school under Cultural (Visual Art) Selective Entry are required to pay all normal school fees and other charges associated with participation in extra-curricular activities.


