As a member of the GPS (Great Public Schools) Association, Brisbane State High School is involved in the wide range of sporting activities coordinated by this organisation.

The school's Enrolment Management Plan (EMP) allows for selective entry in a number of categories. Specific details about the categories, selection processes and timelines for applications can be found on the school website – www.statehigh.com.au. All persons interested in enrolment should read the relevant information.

To identify potential applicants for Sporting Selective Entry - Football for Year 7, 2026, trial football games will be conducted.

Procedures for players wishing to trial are as follows:

- 1. Complete the Selective Entry Online Application form open from Friday 21 March 2025.
- 2. Submit the online application and the required supporting documents by **Tuesday 22 April 2025**, along with:
 - Birth Certificate (copy)
 - Year 5 (2024) Semester 1 and Semester 2 school reports
 - Year 6 (2025) Semester 1 school report (when available)
 - Most current NAPLAN Report
 - Trial registration form (see page 2)
 - Sporting Selective Entry Application Checklist and Student Summary form (see pages 3 5)
 - Evidence of payment of the *Application to Trial* fee (\$100) to be paid via the **Qkr! App**.
 - Please note: A non-refundable, non-transferable *Application to Trial* processing fee of \$100 applies for all applications to trial. For applicants shortlisted for enrolment, this processing fee will be deducted from the \$420 fee applicable for Selective Entry Enrolment applications*.

*Please note, if you have already paid the \$420 Selective Entry fee for another category in 2025, the trial fee is not applicable.

Note: All Selective Entry Applications are required to be completed online via the Selective Entry Online Application form. Students <u>must have</u> demonstrated ability in football (e.g. selection in representative teams/squads), school reports that reflect an ability to cope with the academic demands of the BSHS curriculum and above average behaviour reports.

Trial Information

The trial will be conducted on **Wednesday**, **7 May 2025** at the BSHS Fursden Road Playing Fields, Fursden Road, Carina, **from 3.30pm to 6.00pm**.

Students are required to bring the following items to the trial:

Boots	Jersey	Shorts
Personal protective equipment	Sunscreen	Drink bottle

Students will be responsible for any strapping that they may require.

Post-Trial

Students who are shortlisted, and whose school academic and behaviour reports are deemed to be of a suitably high standard, will proceed to the final stage of the application process. At this time, payment of \$320 for the balance of the non-refundable processing fee required for a Selective Entry application (\$420) will be required to be paid via the Qkr! App.

Note

Brisbane State High School does not offer sporting scholarships. All students who are enrolled into the school under Sporting Selective Entry – Football are required to pay all normal school fees and other charges associated with participation in extra-curricular activities.
