

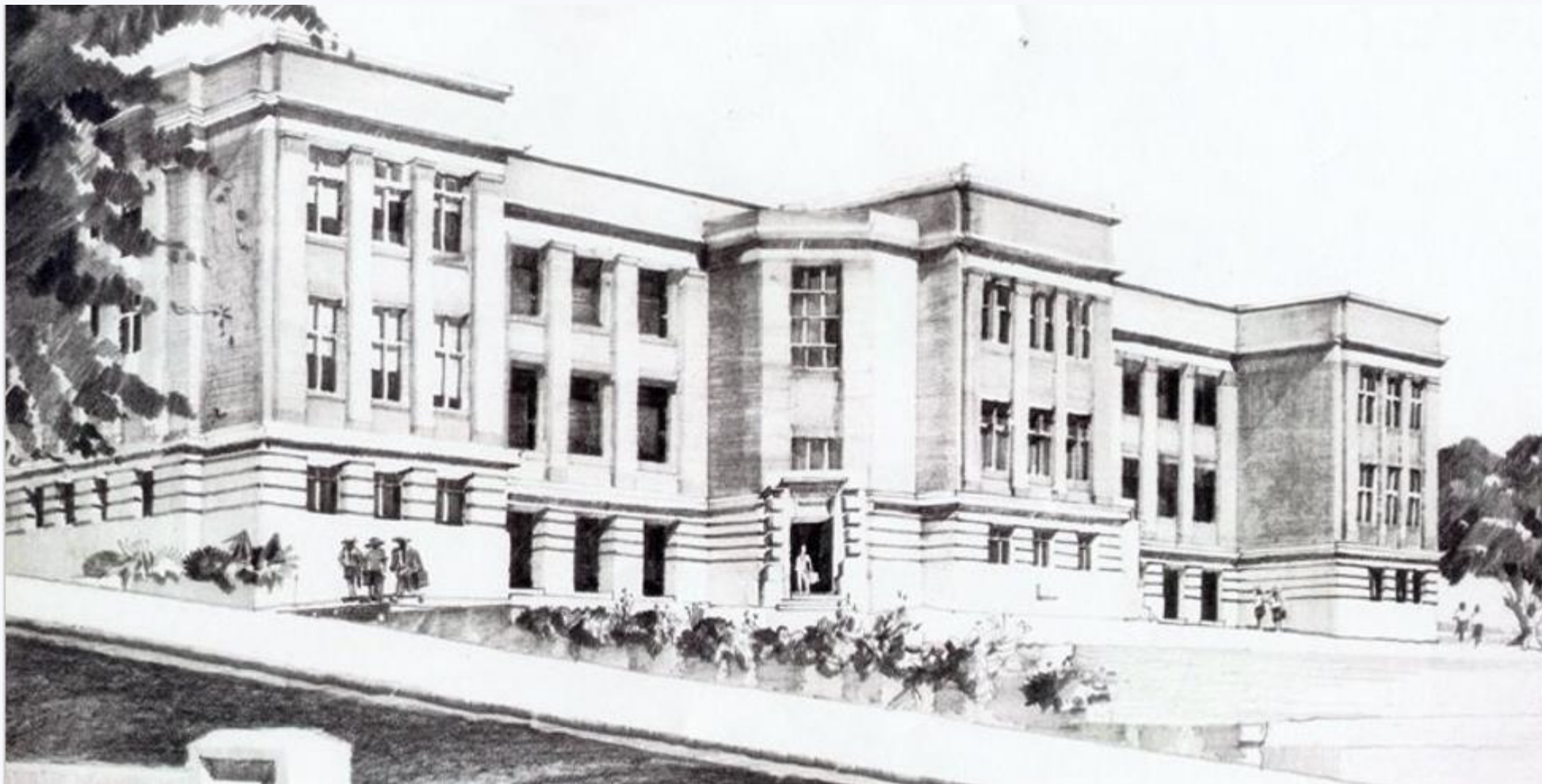

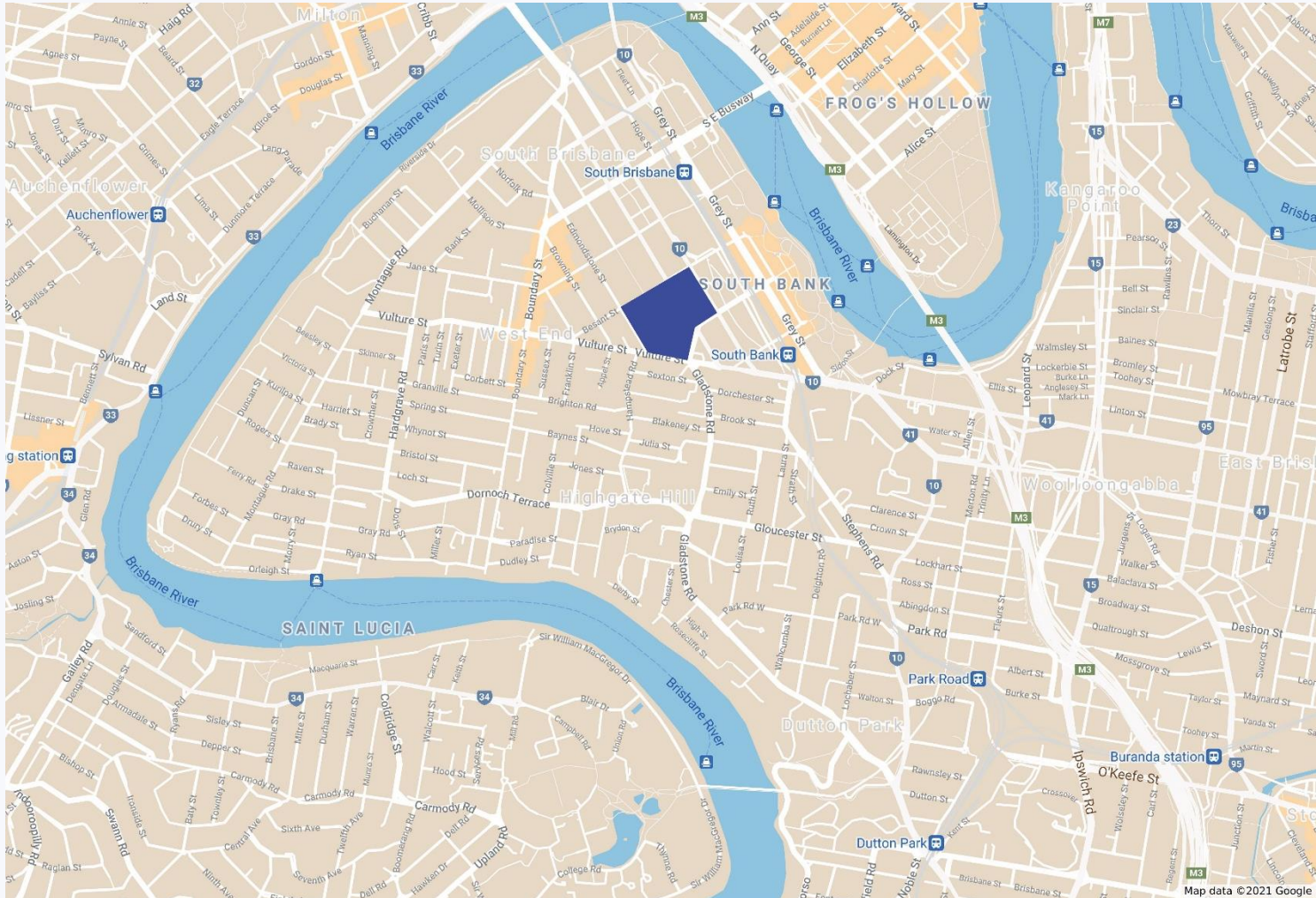

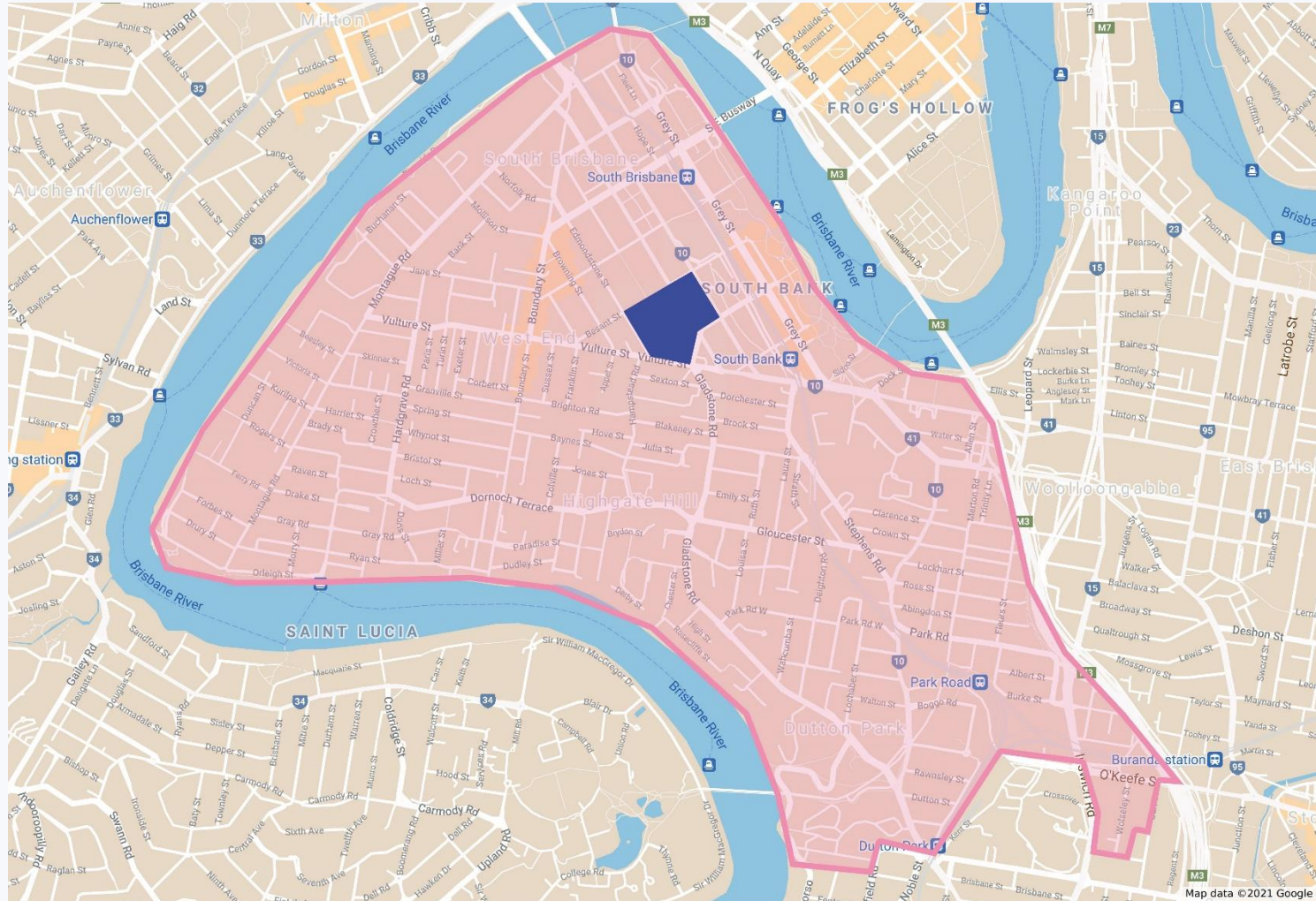
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Brisbane State High School campus



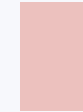
Previous Defined Catchment Area

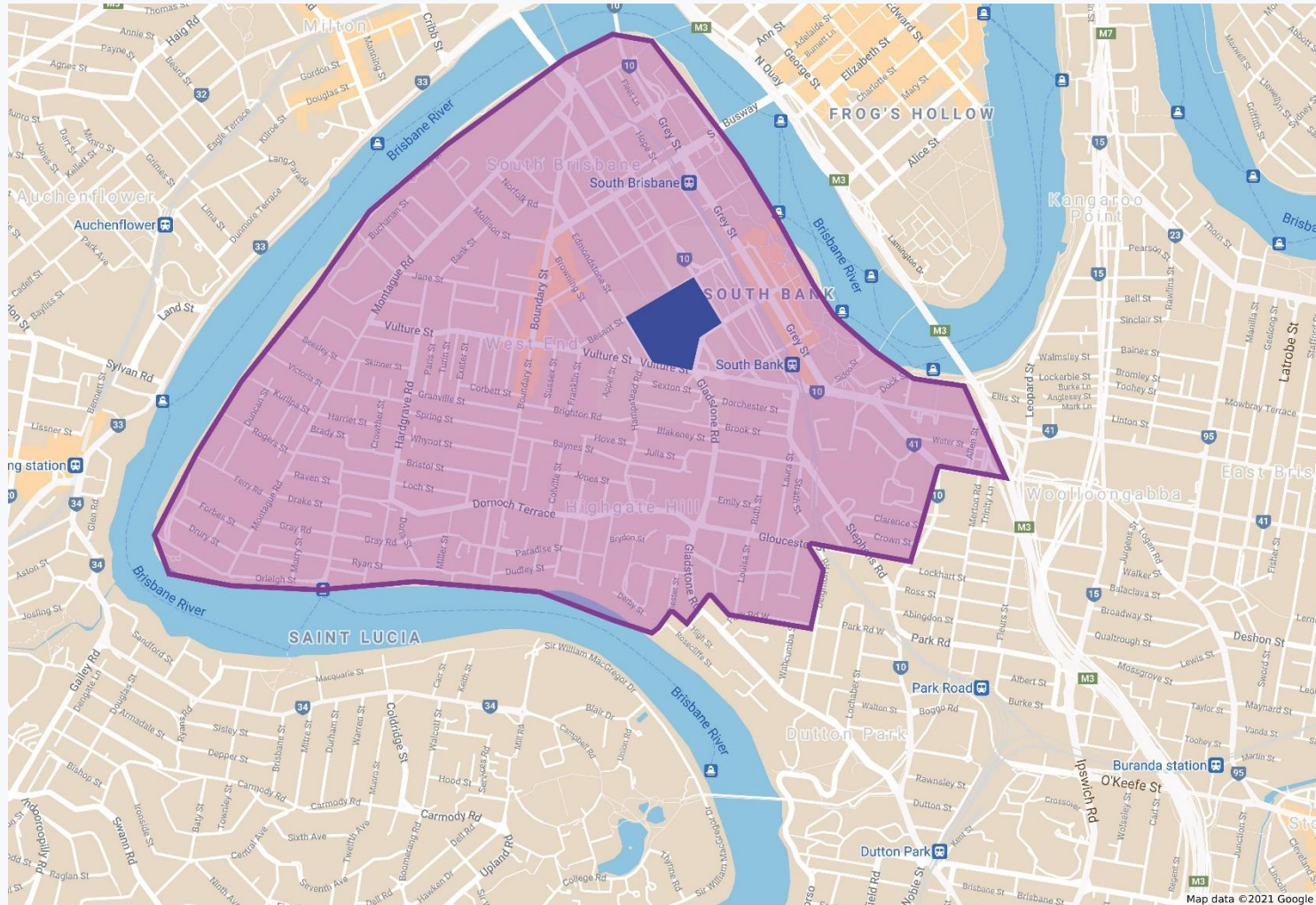
Brisbane State High School campus

Updated Defined Catchment Area



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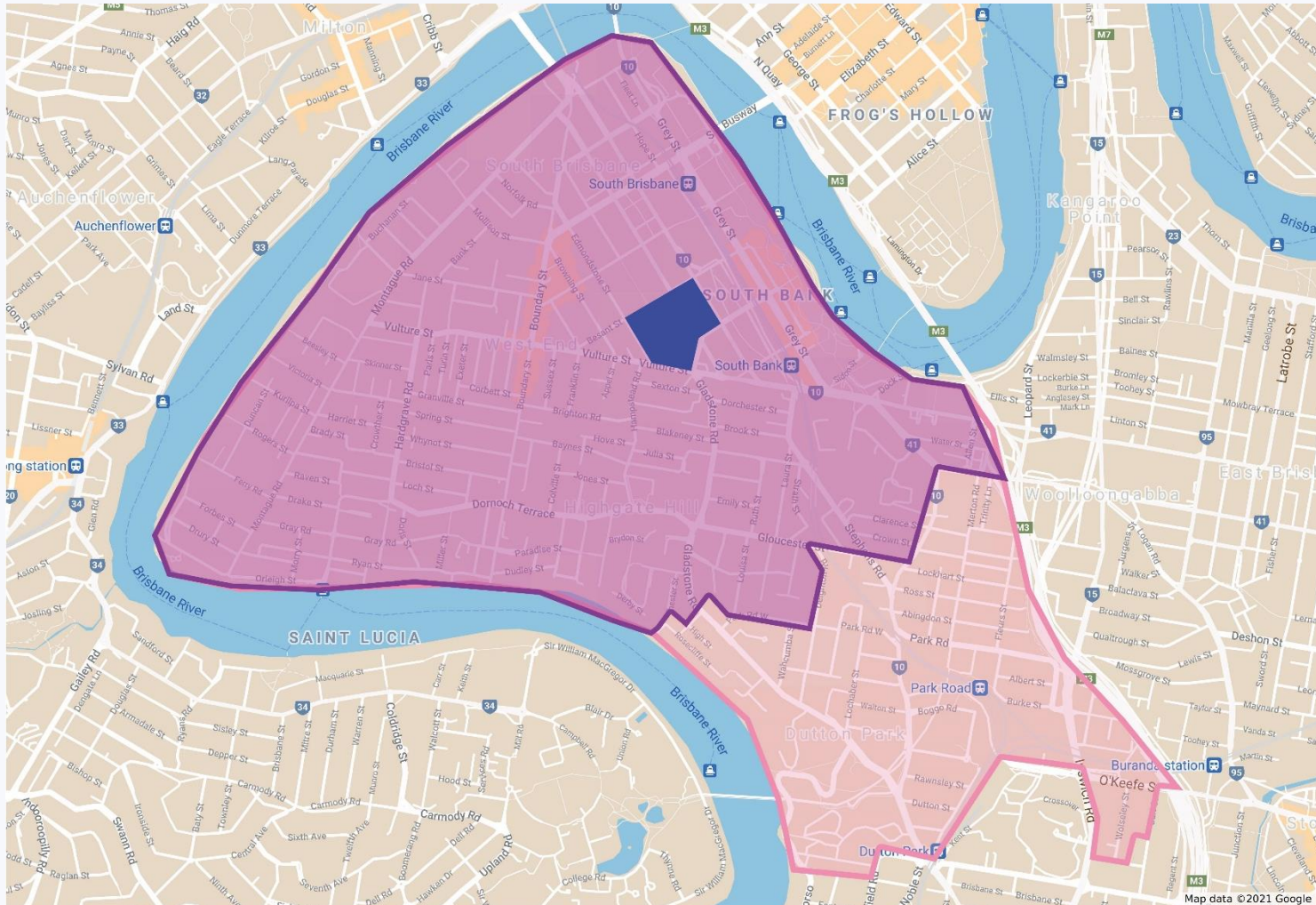

(new area)



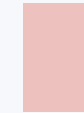
Grandfather Clause 2018 - 2024

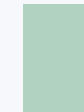

Brisbane State High School Updated Defined Catchment Area (new area)

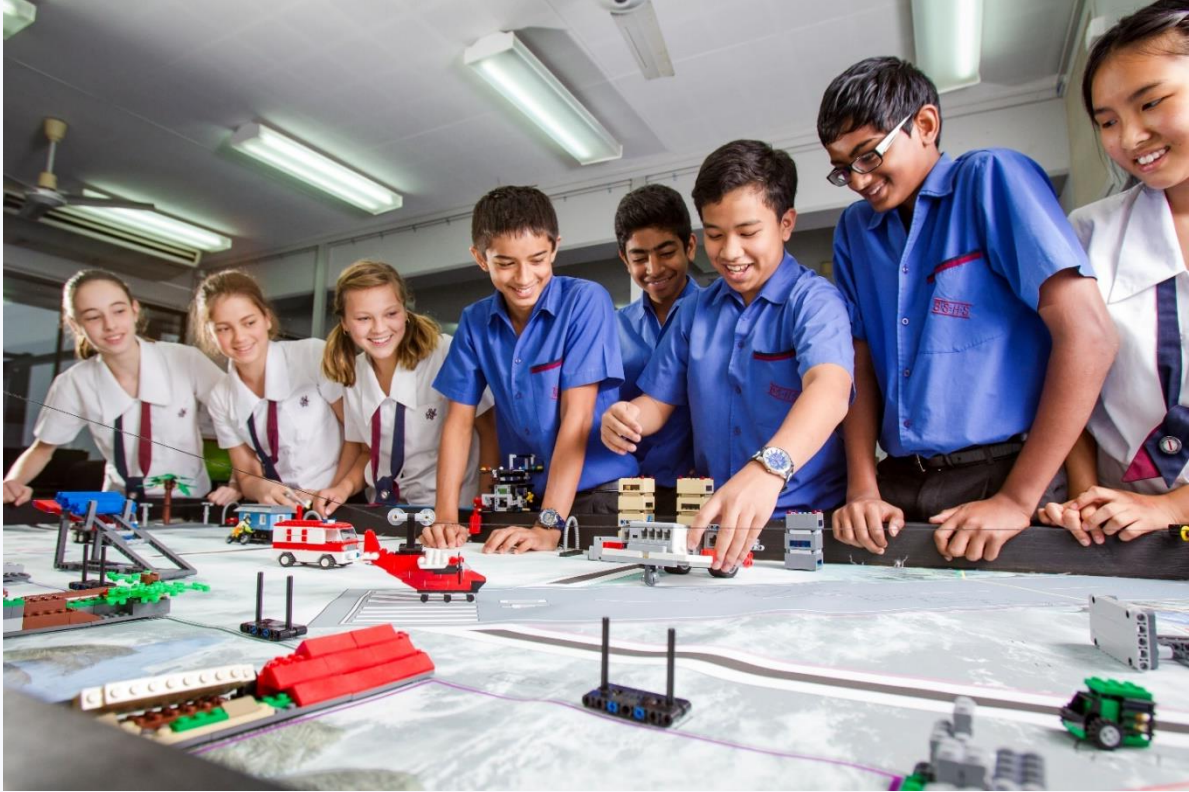
